# **TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF SHIPPING CONTAINERS IN SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING ZONES (RS 6, 8 and 10)**

You must comply with the following requirements for placing a shipping container in single-family dwelling zones (RS 6, 8 and 10):

- One shipping container may be temporarily placed for a maximum of 90 consecutive days for the purposes of temporarily storing or shipping personal property in association with moving or property improvement.
- Temporary shipping containers must be placed on the designated driveway of a residential lot;
- Temporary shipping containers must be situated in such a way as to not obstruct views of oncoming traffic;
- Temporary shipping containers may not be placed within the public right-of-way, and may not be placed in such a manner as to obstruct or impair the free and full use of the sidewalk or street by the public, or obstruct the view of pedestrians or users of vehicles thereon or interfere with the wires, poles or fixtures lawfully maintained thereon;
- Temporary shipping containers shall be at least three feet away from the residential structure, and shall allow for at least five feet of clear access on one side or the other between the structure and the property line.
